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## REQUIREMENTS

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**Program Attendance:** Participants must attend 3 different programs. Examples include: guided hikes, monarch tagging events, bird banding programs, or any other public nature related program.

**Independent Activities:** Participants 6-12 years must complete 2 independent activities. Examples include: camping, hiking, fishing, or other nature related activity. For participants 13-18 years, one of these activities must be a formal volunteer commitment totaling 1 or more hours.
