POTTAWATTAMIE COUNTY BUILDING MASK REQUIREMENT

On November 5, 2020, the Pottawattamie County Board of Supervisors approved a resolution that requires all persons entering any County-owned building to wear a face covering. If a person that needs to conduct business with the County is unable to wear a face covering, they should contact the department directly to make alternate arrangements. Many County services can be completed online.

Additionally, the Pottawattamie County Board of Supervisors implemented a Face Covering Policy for all Pottawattamie County employees in Pottawattamie County-owned facilities and vehicles to protect public health.

“As numbers continue to climb, we’re taking additional measures to protect public health and safety of visitors and employees within our Pottawattamie County-owned facilities,” said Matt Wyant with Pottawattamie County Public Health. “Mask wearing continues to be a proven way to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.”

Pottawattamie County Public Health encourages the use of face coverings as protection in all public settings, especially when social distancing measures are difficult to maintain.
